CONDUCT OF BY-ELECTION FOR NCUNCUNI CONSTITUENCY IN

MMISSION

THE KAVANGO WEST REGION

The Electoral Commission of Namibia (ECN) is at an advanced stage with regards to preparations and implementation of the Election Schedule for the conduct of the Ncuncuni Constituency by-election scheduled to take place on 28 March 2018. The by-election is necessitated by the death of the then sitting councilor, Hon. Councilor Rosa Kavara who passed away on the 2nd of January 2018. According to the Regional Councils Act, if a vacancy occurs in a particular constituency office, the Electoral Commission is obligated in terms of the law to conduct a by-election in that particular constituency within 90 days from the date the vacancy occurred.

To this end, a Supplementary Registration of Voters will take place from 24-27 January 2018. The ECN hereby urges all individuals who are resident in the Ncuncunii

Constituency and are eligible to be registered as voters to go to designated supplementary voter registration points in the Constituency.

In order to be registered as a voter in the upcoming Ncuncuni Constituency by-election, an individual should be a resident of the Ncuncuni Constituency, he/she should be 18 years and above, he/ she must be able to identify him/herself and he/she must be a Namibian citizen.

The supplementary registration of voters is aimed at registering new applicants; individual voters who have changed address and lost their voter cards

All designated supplementary registration points will open at 08h00 until 19h00 as indicated below in the timetable for the Supplementary Registration:
