## MEDIA STATEMENT BY ECN CHAIRPERSON, ADV. NOTEMBA TJIPUEJA ON PROVISIONAL RESULTS FOR 2019 PRESIDENTIAL & NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS

30th November 2019, CERC

The Electoral Commission of Namibia (ECN) hereby wishes to inform the Namibia nation that the process of collating Constituency results from the recently concluded Presidential & National Assembly elections is still ongoing.

We are glad to inform the public that out of the 121 Constituencies, 112 results were received for the Presidential Elections while for National Assembly elections a total of 108 Constituencies have been received. The collation of election results is done on the basis of documents received from Returning Officers of declared constituencies.

In other words, the ECN has not received documentation from all declared Constituencies.

It is important for people to understand that the final announcement of election results in regard to the Presidential and National Assembly elections can only be done after all the votes from all polling stations and all Constituencies have been collated. However, in the interest of the electorate, political parties, candidates and the general public at large, allow me to announce the form Constituencies for which we have received documentation (including the cumulative total and percentage) for the Presidential elections as follows based on the declared Constituencies.

Typically, the challenge being experienced relates to failure of some Returning Officers to send all required documents to the Central Election Results Centre in order for the Commission to satisfy itself with results as announced at respective Constituencies.

The ECN has a responsibility of ensuring that every vote counts and that every vote is accounted for. To this end, in order to ensure the integrity of the process the ECN has put in place stringent administrative measures to ensure the accuracy of final results announced the Central Election Results Centre.

Lastly, the Electoral Commission of Namibia is fully aware of the fake news and disinformation being posted and shared on social media platforms. The Commission has noted with concern, fake news material being circulated by certain established media organisations and personalities. We urge people to desist from such practices and we caution members of the public not be vigilant and not rely on unreliable sources.

We are urging everyone to remain calm and patient while the Electoral Commission completes this important national task.

The final official announcement of results will be done today at a time to be announced and all stakeholders will be informed accordingly.
