EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The Electoral Commission of Namibia (ECN), in accordance with the Public Procurement Act, No. 15 of 2015 read together with the Electoral Operations Policy, hereby invites members of the public to dispose their vehicles for use during the **upcoming Regional Councils and Local Authorities elections scheduled for 26 November 2025.**

Requirements:

The vehicles:

- (a) MUST NOT be older than 10 years
- (b) MUST be a single or double cab 2x4 or 4x4 with a canopy
- (c) MUST be roadworthy
- (d) MUST not have any stickers, slogans or colours bearing messages of political parties, religious or business institutions
- (e) Tyres MUST NOT be older than five years

All vehicles will be subjected to mandatory:

- a) Vehicle inspections and roadworthy testing: All vehicles will undergo inspection and roadworthy testing by the Namibian Police Traffic Unit in the region/constituency of deployment on dates to be announced in due course.
- b) **Signing of Contract:** All owners of the selected vehicles that meet all prescribed inspection and testing requirements, will enter into a contract of agreement with ECN.
- Identity Document: Submit a certified copy of the vehicle owner or proxy's Identity Document (ID copy).
- d) Vehicle Registration Certificate: Submit a certified copy of vehicle registration certificate.
- e) Proof of Vehicle Insurance: All vehicle owners are required to submit proof of their vehicle
 insurance or in absence thereof sign an Indemnity Form for use of vehicle for voter registration
 exercise.

Interested vehicle owners are requested to avail their vehicles for inspection and roadworthy testing from 27 – 31 October 2025 at selected towns across the country as indicated in the table below.
